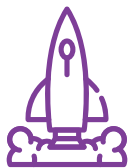


Welcome to a World of Wonder!

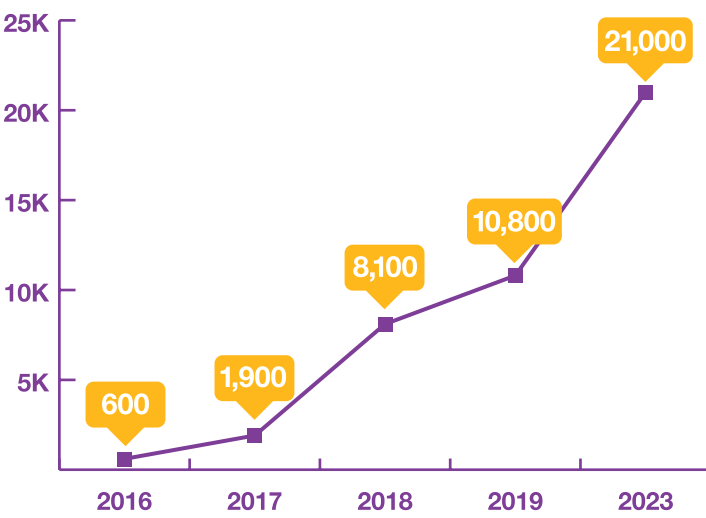
Since its debut in 2016, the Los Angeles Maker Faire has grown exponentially, offering a stage for over 150 exhibitors, including a vibrant mix of engineers, entrepreneurs, artists and scientists, to display their groundbreaking creations. This festive occasion welcomes a diverse crowd of attendees, ranging from tech enthusiasts to curious minds and families seeking a fun, educational, and inspirational experience.

In 2023, the event scaled to new heights at the Los Angeles State Historic Park, which transformed into more than 32 acres of technological wonder that attracted over 21,000 participants. With features like the inspirational opening remarks from Bill Nye, the L.A. Maker Faire has become a landmark event. This year's event, which will once again be held at the L.A. State Historic Park, will build upon the success of 2023 with even longer hours, more STEAM-luminaries, themed zones like the Robot Pavilion and Young Inventors Pavilion and more interactive experiences, transforming the venue into an even grander hub of innovation and community engagement.
