Welcome to a World of Wonder!

The Los Angeles Maker Faire, a collaborative showcase with the City of STEM, is a beacon of invention and DIY innovation in Los Angeles. The largest local event of its kind, the Maker Faire celebrates the gathering of curious and inventive minds.

Since its debut in 2016, the Los Angeles Maker Faire has grown exponentially, offering a stage for more than 200 exhibitors, including a vibrant mix of engineers, entrepreneurs, artists and scientists to display their groundbreaking creations. This festive occasion welcomes a diverse crowd of attendees, ranging from tech enthusiasts to curious minds and families seeking a hands-on experience that is both fun and educational.

The Covid-19 pandemic led to a hiatus between 2020-22, but the event returned with gusto in 2023 when the Los Angeles Maker Faire and City of STEM teamed up to welcome more than 21,000 attendees at the Los Angeles State Historic Park. The event grew even larger in 2024 with the addition of a Young Inventors Pavilion, a Robot Pavilion, a collection of custom low riders showcasing their ingenuity- the epitome of the creative engineering spirit in Southern California, and themed areas with hundreds of exhibitors from around the world, visited by nearly 30,000 inquisitive attendees, not to mention local, national and international media outlets and influencers from the STEM and Maker worlds.

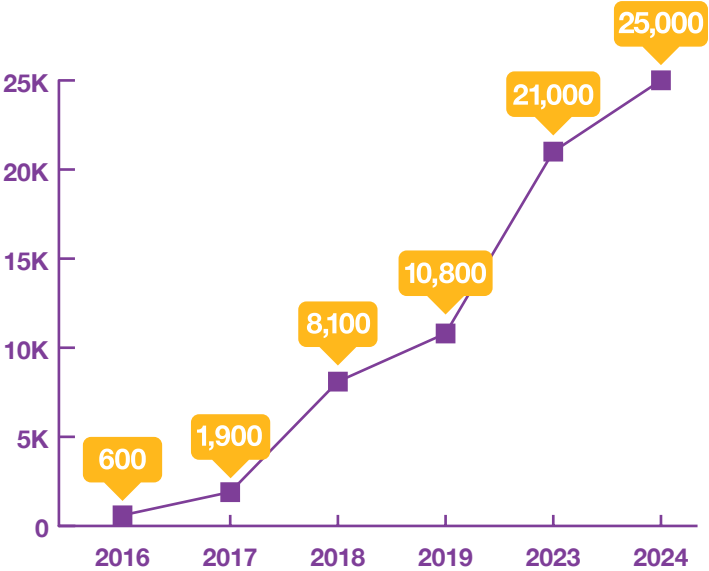
All totaled, the 2024 Maker Faire drew 10.6 million impressions through traditional and social media, setting the stage for an even bigger celebration in 2025.

Given its year-to-year growth, it is no surprise that the Los Angeles Maker Faire has become a must visit event amongst the local scientific and creative community, and a day to remember for thousands of Angelenos.

Who Attends?

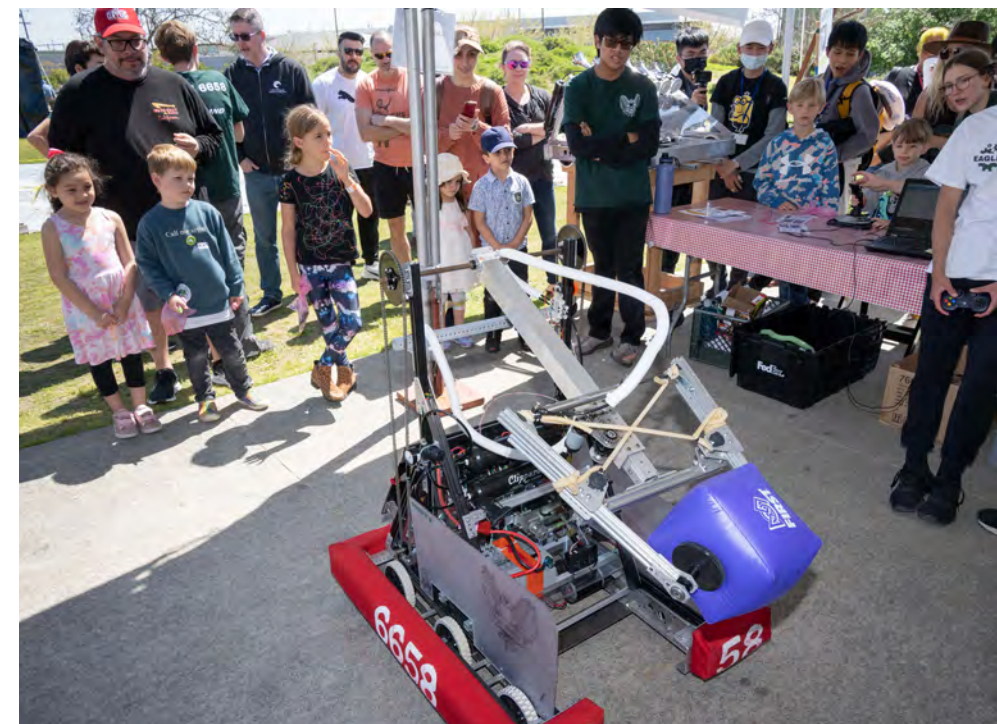
Our diverse audience is the heartbeat of the Faire, encompassing:
